DON'T MISS THIS!!!

The TLUMC Vision Team has scheduled a **guest speaker** come to TLUMC to present information on the projected growth in the Tri-Lakes Area in the next 5-10 years. **Mr. Tom Vierzba of the Northern El Paso County Home Owners Association (NEPCO)**, and a Monument resident for many years, will be in our sanctuary on **Monday, September 17, 7:00 p.m.**, to share his presentation based upon the latest study and research regarding the growth in our area. Many of you are already aware of all the construction, increased traffic, and other signs of the economic boom taking place. The Vision Team sees this growth holding opportunities for our church, and we would like to invite everyone to attend this most timely presentation. Mark your calendars for September 17.



Thank you for your thoughtful feedback and insights through survey responses to the Transformational Church Assessment Tool (TCAT) in May. The church-wide 52% response rate represents a clear indicator that TLUMC people have a strong sense of ownership in our church and its future. The Vision Team reviewed the survey responses and analyzed the results and trends in the data. As a reminder, the survey categories of

Vibrant Leadership, Prayerful Dependence, Missionary Mentality, Relational Intentionality, Worship, Community, and Mission were provided by the TCAT company based on their nationwide research of what leads toward transformational churches.

Your survey responses highlighted multiple strengths for our church, such as effective church leadership, intriguing worship services, prayerful dependence, a growing discipleship process, a strong sense of ownership, leadership involvement in a small group, a timely prayer request system, and informative communication methods. This shows that TLUMC is in a positive place in multiple important areas, but we also have some room for improvement. Areas for improvement are developing a needs-based local missions strategy, outreach to non-Christians outside church, connecting members and newcomers to small groups, comprehending our spiritual gifts, serving in church ministries, devising a system to raise up future leaders, understanding the church vision, and bringing friends to church.

The Vision Team needs your feedback on what opportunities or changes you would like to see at TLUMC as we work to address some of these areas for improvement. Sign up for Focus Groups in the Great Room during the latter half of September so we can hear your thoughts. Thank you again for your attention and interest as we continue to work together to discern what God intends for the future of our church.

Prime Timers (55+)

Wild Animal Sanctuary Trip:

Saturday, September 22, Meet at 7:00 AM TLUMC Parking Lot.

We're rescheduling this excursion for the Prime Timers since our first attempt was cancelled by weather. The Wild Animal Sanctuary is a 720-acre animal sanctuary located at 1946 County Road 53, Keenesburg, Colorado (takes about 1 hour/45 min to get there). The Sanctuary recommends we give ourselves at least three hours to explore on a mile and a half elevated walkway (three miles round trip) above the animal habitats. There is also an education center with videos about the

rescues, a welcome center, and we will have lunch at the Lion's Den Café and Ice Cream Shop. The animals are less active during the heat of the day and the Sanctuary opens at 9AM, which is why we're taking off so early and we will carpool. You must have good walking shoes, a bottle of water, and we suggest you bring a raincoat. Cost is \$30 per person ages 13-69; \$15 for ages 3-15; and free for over 70, but a donation is expected. Royal Gorge Train Ride:

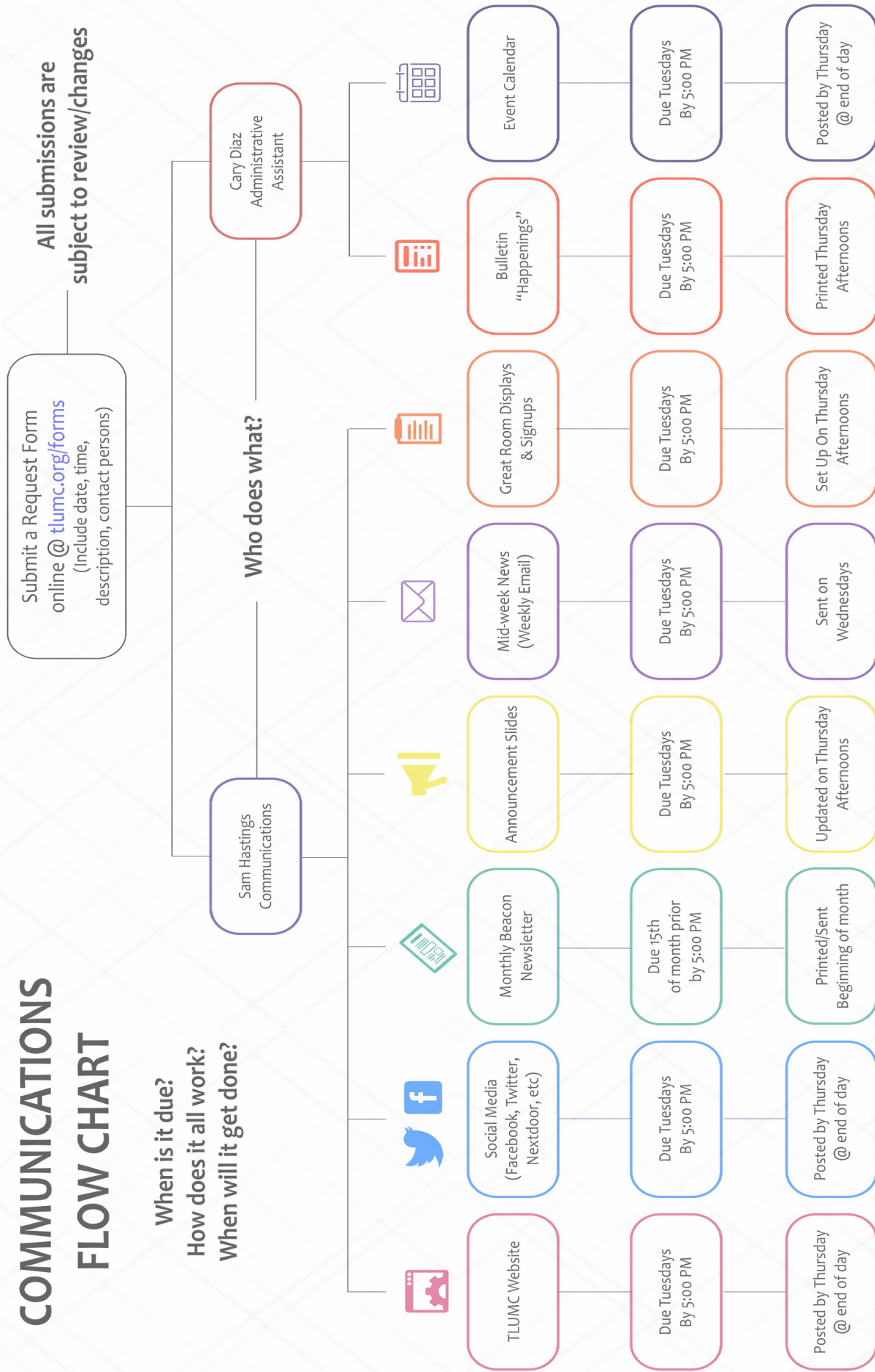

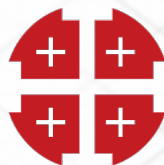
