

## \*New Ways To Watch\*

Can't make it to worship?

There are now multiple ways to watch the livestream of the 11:00 AM service:

1. Visit tlumc.org/live at 11:00 AM on a Sunday and you will find us! Simply click the play button when the media player loads.

2. Watch using the Tri-Lakes UMC mobile App. Simply push the new "Watch Live" button and click the play button when the media player loads.

3. Visit our facebook page (facebook.com/tlumc) at 11:00 AM on a Sunday and you will find us! The stream is public, so there is no need to have a Facebook account to watch.

4. Watch on your TV using an Apple TV (4th generation, 2015 version and higher) or any Roku device. You will need to add the "Sunday Streams" channel, and input TLUMC as the Stream ID. After this one time setup, the stream will be available to you each week by simply opening the channel and clicking play on your device.

This is a great way for those who are traveling, homebound, or even those who have moved away to stay connected to TLUMC on a regular basis.


