speaker. Mark is a retired AF Colonel, who graduated from the USAF Academy in 1970 and received his Master's Degree in Middle East Studies (Arabic language) from the University of Utah. During 26 years of active duty, his assignments in the intelligence career field included serving in Thailand during the Vietnam War, Strategic Air Command Headquarters in Omaha, Tactical Air Command Headquarters in Virginia, NATO in Germany and a Commander at Peterson Air Force Base in Colorado Springs. He also spent five years in the Department of Political Science at the USAF

Academy. He presently teaches at Palmer Ridge High School in Lewis-Palmer School District 38 where he is head of the Social Studies Department teaching American History, AP American History, and Civics. During the summer he is part of a national committee that grades AP exams nationwide.

Mark will be speaking and presenting about the Founding Fathers of our country in a new and interesting way and discussing the ups and downs of the process of developing the US Constitution and Declaration of Independence. An appropriate topic in this political season.
