
MICHELLE FARISS:



After this one time setup, the stream will be available to you each week by simply opening the channel and clicking play on your device.


Crawford House Quilters



Crawford House Quilters is a group within our church that makes quilts for Veterans recovering from drug and alcohol addictions. The quilts are made of recycled jeans and flannel sheets. Each quilt has a religious inspirational card pinned to the quilt in a pocket. The quilts are presented as a gift when a recovery program is completed. So far this year we have donated 45 quilts to Crawford house.

Maggie Reilly's friend met a homeless man on the streets of Colorado Springs with a quilt wrapped around him. She recognized it as one we made. He said that the quilt is the most important thing he owns, and it is a constant reminder that he is loved and needs to take control of his life again. He keeps the card in his pocket and reads it regularly.




