*Call to Worship

Pastor: Ascribe to the LORD, O heavenly beings, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.

All: Ascribe to the LORD the glory of his name; worship the LORD in holy splendor.

Pastor: The voice of the LORD is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over mighty waters.

All: The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.

Pastor: The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars; the LORD breaks the cedars of Lebanon.

All: He makes Lebanon skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young wild ox.

Pastor: The voice of the LORD flashes forth flames of fire.

All: The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; the LORD shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.

Pastor: The voice of the LORD causes the oaks to whirl, and strips the forest bare; and in his temple all say, "Glory!"

All: The LORD sits enthroned over the flood; the LORD sits enthroned as king forever.

**We believe in one God,
