

## Daily Devotional Guide

**Verses of the Week:** “So kings, wise up! Be warned, you rulers of the earth! Serve the LORD reverently — trembling, kiss his feet or else he will become angry, and your way will be destroyed because his anger ignites in an instant. But all who take refuge in the LORD are truly happy!” (Psalm 2:10-12, CEB).

### Daily Prayer:
